High quality management skills and standards of work ashore and on board are promoted via Over and Above STCW training, on the job familiarization, realistic drills and compliance with Best Industry practices.













Customer complaints and Cargo Claims are being monitored via measurable targets incorporated in yearly **Key Performance Indicators**.


Last five-year analysis of relevant KPI evidences robust operational practices with close to **ZERO cases per vessel** for an approximate total of 200 voyages executed yearly.

All vessels were built at First Class Korean yards (**SUNGDONG, HYUNDAI SAMHO, HHI**), highly reputable yards in China (**JIANGSU NEW YANGZIJIANG, NEW TIMES SHIPBUILDING, COSCO ZHOUSHAN, JINHAIWAN**), Japan (**NAMURA**) and Europe (**DAEWOO MANGALIA**).

Vessels are of high-spec designs, fitted with equipment and systems which meet Class/Flag requirements and on cases exceed industry safety and environmental standards.

All managed vessels are equipped with energy saving devices, such as PBCF, Flow Control Fin, Becker Mewis Duct, for **energy efficiency and voyage optimization**.

It is **company policy** to apply silicone paint on in order to ensure long-term efficiency with less fouling rate.




Total Cargo Transported 2021


#### 2021 CO2 Emissions per Transport

Greek nationals are being recruited directly by Managers.








#### RIGTSHIP BENCHMARK GHG RATING


World DOC Fleet GHG Rating
